

Setup

- Sit back-to-back so you cannot see each other's cards.
- Each player holds 2 cards: "Me" (about yourself) and "You" (about your partner).

How to Play

1. Take turns flipping one card.
2. Read the question aloud. Example: "Who is more likely to cry at a film?"
3. Answer by choosing Me or You.
4. Both reveal answers at the same time.

Special Cards (Left & Right Arrows)

- Some question cards have a ← or → arrow.
- If the card shows a left arrow (←), the player must guess the answer of the person on their left.
- If the card shows a right arrow (→), the player must guess the answer of the person on their right.
 - Example: "What is the shoe size?" If the arrow is ←, you answer what you think the person on your left would say.

Scoring

- Match your partner's answer: 1 point
- No match: 0 points
- Continue until all cards are played.

Tips

- Be honest, but answer what you're comfortable with.
- Have fun! Laugh, discuss, and enjoy discovering each other.
- The real win is connection, not competition.

Put all cards on the table. Know each other. Have fun. ❤️
